# Commodore's Comments

Dear Fellow Members.

As I wrote in my
September 20th letter, the
BOS made a difficult
decision at its last meeting,
proposing a dues increase
beginning with the
November billing. The dues
will increase by \$100 for
each paying member per
year or \$100 for each nonresident account per year.
The increase works out to
be \$25 per quarterly billing
or \$8.33 per month.

There are several reasons for the increase costs of running the Yacht Club. One reason is an increase in our property insurance. After appraisal, our building was valued over 1 million dollars, but our current property insurance only covers the building for about half a million dollar loss. This increase in insurance coverage plus increases in other insurances besides property will cost an extra \$5415 per year.

We have estimated cost of \$6000 to cover legal

expenses associated with the lawsuit with Palmetto Bay Marina.

The final increase is the cost of paying back our bank loan on the new deck. We would like to pay back the loan in 54 months, when a balloon payment will be due. Paying it back at this rate will cost \$1430.63 per month or \$17,167.56 this fiscal year. In order to maintain our financial strength, a dues increase is recommended for the next fiscal year.

The YCHHI Annual Meeting has been scheduled for Friday, October 14th at 5 p.m. The Change of Watch is planned for Saturday, November 5th, beginning at 6 p.m.
