## *Commodore's Comments*

### **Club Communications:**

We are evaluating both the EVITE and CONSTANT CONTACT communications facilities to determine which is the better choice for our club communications, including dinner meetings, boating activities, announcements, etc. There was a little confusion this past week due to learning curve and growing pains, but the coming weeks will be under control with no problems and with definite benefits.

### **Club Dock:**

Our **floating dock** has been moved away from the Palmetto Bay Marina dock, where it has resided in various forms over the past many years. This change is due to some disagreements between our club and Cross Island Associates (CIA), which owns the Palmetto Bay Marina, the property encompassing the restaurants, the Palmetto Bay Boat Yard and many unnumbered parking spaces outside of our parking area. CIA is unhappy about our members and guests parking in spaces outside of our lot, as this consumes spaces needed for customers of their restaurants and shops. Also, they would like to be permitted to park a number of their cars inside of our lot, which our membership will not allow. It is important that we do not park in any of their unnumbered spaces. We do have permission to park in any of the numbered spaces when truly necessary. We are looking into alternative means for docking our small boats.

### **Bylaw Change:**

A bylaw change regarding the parameters for non-resident status was approved by the board and will be presented for ratification at the annual meeting in October. The change relates to increasing the duration of time that a member may reside on HHI and still qualify for non-resident status. Details will be provided in advance of the meeting.

### **Refrigeration:**

The pre-owned, refurbished industrial grade refrigerator is now installed in the kitchen, and is being readied for service. The old, under-counter fridge will be replaced by shelving.

### **New Members:**

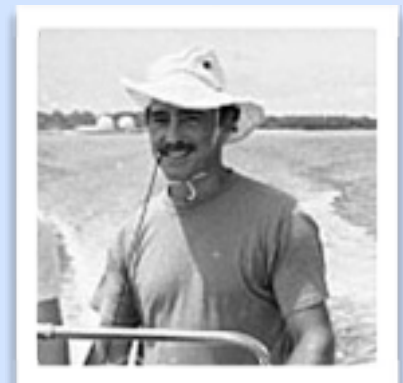
The club welcomed six new members over the past month: Mary Ryan, Erin Rota, Mathew and Barbara Roe, Charles and Brenda Showfety.
